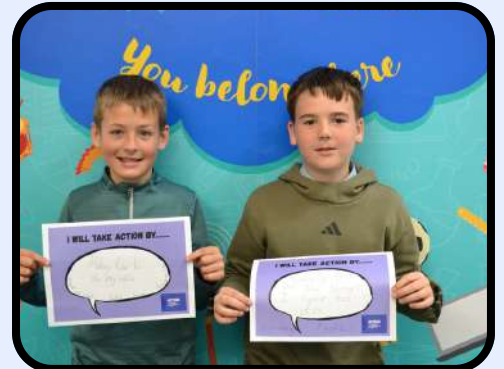

## YEAR 6 NEWS

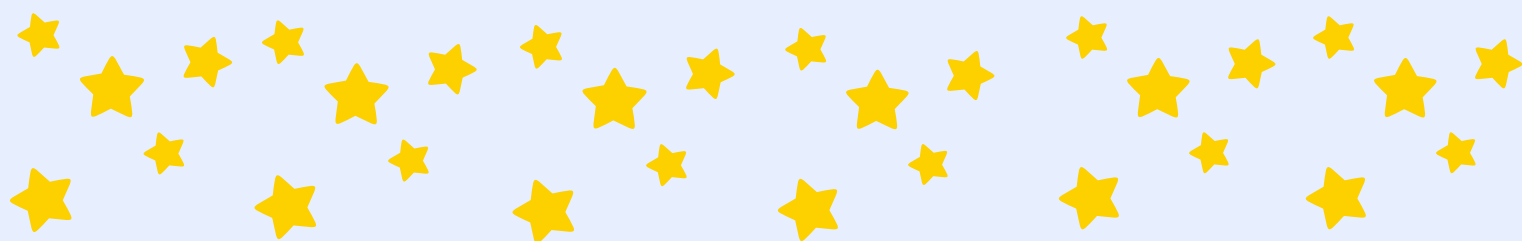

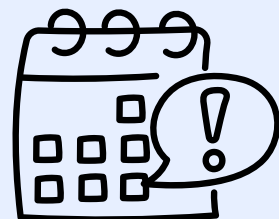

## Hoop Earrings

A reminder that, for safety reasons, hoop earrings are not permitted. Our uniform policy allows one plain gold or silver stud in each ear.

## Celebration Assembly - Creche

A gentle reminder that we provide a crèche during Celebration Assembly for any younger siblings who attend, and you are very welcome to make use of this.

Our assemblies are a special time for pupils to share and celebrate their achievements, and they can occasionally run a little longer. While we completely understand that younger children may become restless, noise from siblings can sometimes make it difficult for pupils to concentrate and fully enjoy the moment. Making use of the crèche can really help create a calm and focused atmosphere for everyone.

If you would like to use the crèche, please speak to a member of staff at the start of Celebration Assembly, who will be happy to help.



## Collecting and Drop-off

A reminder that children should arrive at school between 8:35 and 8:50am each morning, entering school through the main playground gate (or Reception classroom door). Please do not drop your child to the main office between these times.

End of day collection for all pupils is at 3:20pm. We ask that children are not collected earlier than this, except in exceptional circumstances. If you have need to collect your child early, please inform the school office in advance (via phone or email), providing an appointment letter if appropriate. Children arriving late or being collected early regularly disrupts their learning and means they miss out on important social time with their peers.

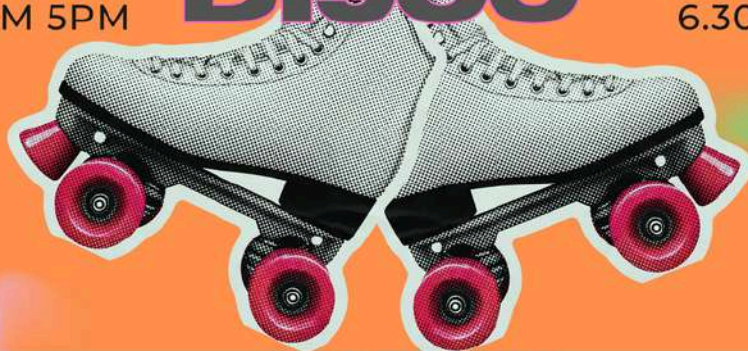
