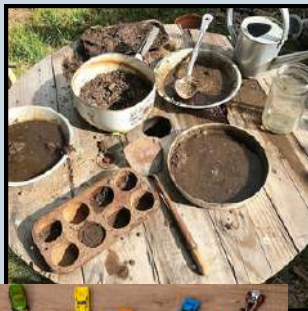
Uniform
