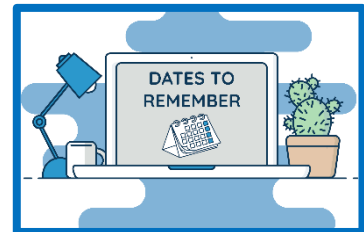


**Important Information:**
