
<u>Literacy</u>

Our first class text will be 'Dogger' by Shirley Hughes. We will be learning about descriptions, and we will focus on making a poster describing Dogger.



<u>Art and Design & Technology</u>

We will be exploring the work of the famous artist Claude Monet, known for his beautiful Impressionist landscapes. We will use oil pastels and palette paints to create our own artwork inspired by the four seasons.



<u>RSE & Values</u>

In our Jigsaw lessons we will focus on our dreams and goals. We will explore how to set personal aspirations, work towards achieving them, and understand the importance of perseverance and self-belief.



Topic Highlights

This half term, our learning will revolve around the theme of *Toys Through Time*. We will have a 'Wow Day' at the end of term to consolidate our learning and make different toys from different eras.

<u>Science</u>

We will be learning about seasonal changes. We will observe how weather, daylight, and nature transform throughout the year and explore how we can measure rainfall and the wind direction.



Computing

In computing we will be learning about Digital Writing. We will practice using a keyboard effectively and learn how to add and remove text in a Microsoft Word document.





In RE, our learning question is 'Who do Christians say made the world'? We will learn about what a creator is and discuss the creation story.

<u>Maths</u>

We will be focussing on learning to recognise, compose, decompose and manipulate 2D and 3D shapes. After that, we will move onto learning about numbers 0-10.



Physical Education

In PE, we will be focusing on Games and developing our multi-Skills. We will practice a range of fundamental movement skills, including coordination, balance, and teamwork, to enhance our overall physical abilities.



<u>Geography</u>

In geography, our learning question is, 'What is the United Kingdom'. We will explore its four countries, their capital cities, and key features, developing our understanding of what makes up the UK.



<u>Music</u>

We will be learning about patterns and stories. We will explore how repeated rhythms and melodies create patterns and discover how music can tell a story or convey emotions.
