We will be reading books about our topic and upcoming Autumn celebrations.

Year 1-Autumn 2

Topic: Colours of the World!



Maths

We will be looking closely at the composition of numbers from 0-5. We will be thinking about how we partition these numbers and will be developing strategies to do this in a systematic way.



We will also continue to develop our number formation and counting skills.

Art and Design & Technology

We will have lots of opportunities to make and create our own art and models to learn new skills and utilise the skills we have been taught.

We will be learning about mechanisms and how we can use them to create moving pictures. We will be creating a design plan and will use different mechanisms to bring our pictures to life.



Science

We will continue thinking about animals and how we can group them based on their features. We will be learning about what different animals eat and how we can find evidence of whether they are an omnivore, carnivore or herbivore.



Physical Education

In our PE lessons we will be exploring dance on the theme of travel. We will explore how we can move like different vehicles, drawing inspiration from toys, pictures and video. We will compose dance routines that involve travelling on a journey.



Computing

We will be learning how to paint using a computer or laptop. We will look at how we can make lines and shapes and will recreate some famous artworks digitally.

Geography

We will be learning about our local area. We will be looking at rural and urban areas and will be spotting the features of Kingstone. We will go on a walk around the village to decide whether Kingstone is a rural or urban area. We will also be looking at symbols on an Ordnance Survey map and will create our own maps.



RSHE

We will be celebrating the things that make us special and unique and will notice the things that we have in common with our friends. We will also look at bullying and learn how we can identify this and how to ensure that we are always being kind to others.



Music

We will be exploring the materials and sounds of percussion instruments. We will be performing using a steady beat and will begin spotting repeating patterns in songs.

RE

In RE we will begin learning about Judaism. We will explore key Jewish beliefs and stories from the Torah. We will learn why they are important to Jewish people today.
