Year 4 Visit to Raglan Castle



Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to say that we have secured a visit to Raglan Castle, on **Friday 17th April 2026**. The cost of the trip is **£2 per child**.

The trip will be a wonderful way to start Year 4 History topic, 'How has Herefordshire changed, since 1066?' In this unit the children will learn about life in Hereford during the Civil War. The children will learn about the significance of local castles. During the visit to Raglan, the children will see what has been left since it fell into disrepair. They will use their skills as historians to decide if the castle was built in a good position and will imagine what life may have been like there, during the English Civil War.

For the trip, children should wear school uniform with either trainers or wellies, dependent on the weather. All children will need a water bottle and a packed lunch. If you book a hot lunch for your child on this day, they will be provided with a packed lunch by Miquill. We will leave after registration and return before the end of the day so collection will be as normal. We will be travelling in school minibuses.
