## **Maths**



As the national times table check is getting nearer, please help your child to regularly engage with the activities set on Times Table Rockstars. We encourage all children to complete at least 10 minutes of TTRS each week. In order to be ready for the times table check in June, the children will need to know all tables facts up to 12x12.

Alongside TTRS, it is important for all children to keep up with their mental addition and subtraction skills. Numbots is designed to do this and so all children are expected to work on completing each stage, up to Diamond.
