

Writing

This half-term, we will be exploring a series of short burst activities. The children will also be writing their own version on a traditional tale. We will be exploring more explicit grammar activities to ensure the children understand the impact of more complex sentence structure and punctuation.

Reading

The children will be working on reading fluency. We will also continue to work on their comprehension skills, paying particular attention to 3 key areas:

- Vocabulary
- Inference skills
- Summarising

Maths

This half term we will continue to rehearse the four operations . We will also further our problem solving skills as well as fine tuning general arithmetic skills. The children will be focusing on fractions, decimals and percentages, linking this with ratio and algebra.

Art

In Art sessions this half term, we will be exploring the skill of printing. We will focus on the techniques used by Andy Warhol and William Morris.

Music

In Music we will be exploring notation further, using chords and structure.

Geography

Our Geography unit this half term is a whole term unit. We will be exploring mountains and rivers around the world.

RSHE

In RSHE, we will be looking at keeping safe and happy. We will be continuing our work on mental health and discussing how to keep safe in a variety on contexts.

PE

In PE, we will be completing the Crystal Star Challenge. We will be focusing on our netball skills.

Computing

Our Computing lessons will focus on the skill of data and interpreting information. We will learn about spreadsheets, linking this to our mathematical understanding.

Science

Our Science focus for this half-term is a whole term topic. The children will be exploring light. They will learn how light travels, how we can break light up and how light can be effectively used in marketing. We will also be exploring circuits, building on knowledge from Year 4 to support our DT project for next half term.

Religious Education

In the run up to Easter, we will be exploring the key question: What do Christians believe Jesus did to save people? We will be exploring the Easter story and the importance of it to Christians.

French

In Year 6, children will continue to develop and broaden their vocabulary and writing of simple sentences.
