# Writing

For the last half term of Year 6, we will be reviewing our writing so far this year and our writing journey along with it. We will be rewriting some pieces of work as well as having a chance to write independently for a range of purposes applying the skills we have learnt so far.

#### Reading

To summarise a year of great reading, we will be focusing on sharing our love for reading across the school and beyond.

We will be writing book reviews, sharing stories, modelling fluent and confidence expression as well as continuing our Book Talk sessions.

#### Maths

This half term we will be reviewing some of the tricky topics from previous terms: equations, fractions and pie charts as well as continuing to use our arithmetic skills. We will also be looking at data and statistics this term – linking this knowledge to other topics.

## Art

In Art sessions this half term, we will be exploring the artistic style of **Tim Burton & Lorenzo Mattoti**. We will be focusing the the skill of 3D in a range of mediums.

#### RSHE

In RSHE, we will be looking at 'Changing Me'. We will be discussing how bodies change and how we reproduce. We will also discuss how it feels to go through puberty and concerns the children might have at High School.

# Music

In Music, we will be rehearsing songs from a range of eras for our end of year production.

## ΡE

In PE, we will be learning dances for our Year 6 production. We will also have an athletics week in the style of The Olympic Games.

#### **Religious Education**

Our key question in RE this half term is: How does faith work when times get hard? We will be exploring the advice of different religions and what advice we might give.

## French

In Year 6, children will be continuing their French skills by learning a range of songs to consolidate their learning.

#### Geography

Our Geography unit this half term will focus on Culture across Great Britain. We will be looking back at different history periods in Great Britain and looking at evidence for different cultures.

# Computing

Our Computing lessons will focus on the skill of programming. We will be programming micro bits for a range of purposes.



Our Science focus for this halfterm is electricity. We will discuss the discovery of electricity and what we use to measure it. We will then plan an investigation that explores the variations in how components function and then, using our maths skills, we will be recording our findings.
