How has your school's spending improved PE attainment?	There is a broad and balanced curriculum in place with clear progression between lessons and year groups. Team teaching from sports specialists has developed staff confidence and ideas, which has then impacted on the quality of PE lessons for our children. Top up swimming has also ensured our children are proving to be more 'happy in the water' earlier on in the year after having regular swimming sessions year on year.
How has your school's spending increased pupil PE and sport activity levels?	There has been an increase in participation of active play at break and decrease in lunchtime incidents. Additional equipment purchased has been introduced at break and lunchtimes and all children use this equipment effectively.
How has your school's spending increased school sport participation?	Our offer of free clubs and a wide range of active clubs, has increased the number of children attending. Paying membership fees for Stride Active competitions has also helped to increase school sport participation.
How has your school's spending increased pupil participation in extra-curricular activities?	We continue to offer free clubs to all children, by employing sports specialist to promote and run a variety of clubs for boys, girls and mixed. This allows all children to access clubs, regardless of their individual needs.
How has your school's spending increased staff training and continued professional development (CPD)?	Team teaching from sports specialist has developed staff confidence and ideas. We have worked with community clubs, such as Herefordshire cricket, who have provided CPD for staff. Additional staff CPD time devoted to PE development.

We continue to employ specialist staff to lead accessible afterschool clubs. Staff also work alongside community clubs, such as Burghill Gold Club, to deliver after school clubs.

How has your school's spending improved water safety awareness?	Ensuring our children access swimming lessons or top up sessions, has ensured water safety lessons have been taught to all our children, regardless of swimming ability or level.
