Dear Parents and Carers,

On Monday 5<sup>th</sup> February we will be supporting the Midlands Air Ambulance charity by holding a 'Wear it Red Day!'

Now in its third year, Wear it Red Day encourages primary schools in the Midlands to dress in red to show their support for the Midlands Air Ambulance Charity. Last year, more that 30 school wore red, which raised over £6,000 for the charity. This funded four lifesaving missions, two by air ambulance and two by critical care cars. We are looking forward to showing our support this year.

On our Wear it Red Day, a representative from Midlands Air Ambulance is coming to school to speak to the children about the incredible work that they do.

On Monday 5<sup>th</sup> January, children are encouraged to come to school wearing an item, or a whole outfit of red. Please note that other than their red items, children should wear their school uniform as normal. If your child has PE or Forest School on a Monday they are welcome to swap their usual clothing for something red, a red football shirt for example.

If children have chosen to support this day by wearing an item of red, they should bring in a minimum donation of £1. All money raised will go directly to the Midlands Air Ambulance Charity.
