Dear Parents and Carers,

<u>Uniform</u>

It has been wonderful to see how smartly everyone has started school! Our smart uniform is something that we are proud of - when everyone is in the same uniform, it really helps to unite the children and keep standards high. We are going to be working hard to ensure that this is maintained throughout the year, and really appreciate your support with this. I understand how difficult it can be to source uniform, so do check out our fantastic Eco Rail of pre-loved uniform (via the school office) – we can usually find a match, or keep an eye out for a particular size if there is something you need. We also sell ties, PE t-shirts and hoodies via ParentPay for a very reasonable price. We try really hard to make sure that all the children go home with the right belongings, and really appreciate it if you can name every item to help us with this!

One Page Profiles

At the start of each academic year, each class teacher puts together a One Page Profile to give specific information to support each individual. During this conversation they discuss interests, things they find tricky, and what helps them to be the best learner they can be; this page includes all the information that we need to ensure that each child has their voice heard, and their needs met. As well as the voice of the child, we also like to seek the views of parents and carers to give as a rounded picture of your child; a printed copy of this has been sent home today with your child. If you could return this to Miss Nicholas as soon as possible, the information will be collated to form their final One Page Profile.

Celebration Assembly

Each Friday we hold a Celebration Assembly – they are always a highlight of my week! We love to see parents and carers at these assemblies, and you will be very welcome to join us on any Friday at 9am. We give Reception a little longer to settle into school routines before they start coming to assembly, but we will let you know when they are ready to join in with the rest of the school so that you can come along if you are able. If your child is Star of the Week, I send a secret text out to you the night before

so that you can make special arrangements to be there if you would like to. I look forward to seeing you if you're able to attend over the coming weeks.

Lunches

Just a reminder that all hot school dinners must be booked in advance, by Thursday evening. School meals are free to all Reception (and infant) children, but they still need to be booked so that the correct food can be ordered for each child.
