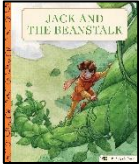


Literacy

We will be reading fairy tale stories and books linked to our topic.

These include:

- The Magic Porridge Pot
- Jack and the Beanstalk
- The Snow Queen
- The Princess and the Pea



We will be writing about the stories we read and about other areas of our topics.

We will continue to read and write the Year 1 common exception words.

This topic web gives a brief outline of some of the activities that we will be exploring in Year 1 during this half-term. We will have lots of time to take part in both child and adult led activities.

Don't forget that lots of these activities can be continued at home too.

Year 1- Summer 1 Topic: Happily Ever After



Maths

We will be looking closely at the numbers 0-20. We will be thinking about how we can split them into tens and ones. We will also think about addition and subtraction. We will learn that the addition and subtraction facts we know to 10 can also be applied to 20.



We will continue to practise counting in our 2s, 5s and 10s.

Art and Design & Technology

We will have lots of opportunities to make and create our own art and models to learn new skills and utilise skills we have been taught.



We will be making our own porridge and will be thinking about our favourite ingredients and flavours.

Science

In our Science lessons we will begin thinking about materials. We will be naming everyday materials and will be conducting an investigation into whether thicker paper will keep our ice cubes from melting for the longest.



Physical Education

In our PE lessons we will be doing athletics. We will be thinking about running techniques and how we can change direction. We will also be thinking about creating obstacles and exploring how we can get over them.



Computing

We will begin exploring programming. We will use the Beebots and will input instructions for them to follow. We will learn how to use the buttons and will plan routes for the Beebots to follow.

Geography

We will be thinking about the seasons and weather in Kingstone. We will be finding clues to decide which season we are in and will be recording the daily weather in Kingstone. We will create a weather diary and will think about the activities we can do in each weather.



RSHE

We will be exploring relationships. We will be thinking about the members of our family and how families can look different. We will think about the people that are special to us and the qualities that make them special. We will also think about the people that help us both inside and out of school.



Music

We will be exploring the seasons and weather through music. We will be performing action songs about the weather and will use percussion instruments to add weather sounds.



RE

In RE we will be learning about Muslims and how they live. We will begin exploring some of the key religious concepts. We will learn about the importance of Allah to Muslims and will look at some of the stories in the Qu'ran. We will learn about how Muslims treat the Qu'ran and why this is so important to them.
