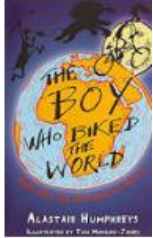


## Literacy

## Half Term Highlights

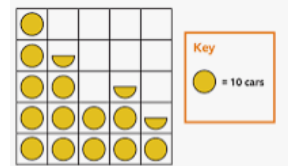
