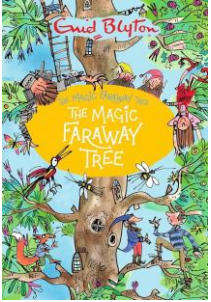


Literacy

Our class text will be the Magic Faraway Tree by Enid Blyton.



We will be writing 'Who am I?' description cards based on animals. We will be writing instructions for and making sandwiches and bird feeders. We will also be sharing and learning to recite, our favourite poems by Micheal Rosen, as well as writing our own.

Forest School

We will have a weekly forest school session to help enhance and deepen our classroom learning in a less structured, more organic way. We will have more freedom to pursue our own interests and spend time in the fresh air.
