Home Reading

Please make sure to continue logging reading as often as you are able. At this stage in the year, we would like children to be reading 4-5 times a week at home as this is one of the best ways to improve their reading fluency and expression. Just reading 2-3 pages or for 5-10 minutes each night is more than adequate and enough to help your child progress.
